## Urgency 22

## Revelation 16:1-21 The Seven Bowls

<sup>1</sup> Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out the <sup>[a]</sup>bowls of the wrath of God on the earth."

**First Bowl: Loathsome Sores** <sup>2</sup> So the first went and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a <sup>b</sup> foul and loathsome sore came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.

**Second Bowl: The Sea Turns to Blood** <sup>3</sup> Then the second angel poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood as of a dead *man*; and every living creature in the sea died.

Third Bowl: The Waters Turn to Blood <sup>4</sup> Then the third angel poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they became blood. <sup>5</sup> And I heard the angel of the waters saying: "You are righteous, <sup>©</sup>O Lord, The One who is and who <sup>©</sup>I was and who is to be, Because You have judged these things. <sup>6</sup> For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, And You have given them blood to drink. <sup>©</sup>For it is their just due." <sup>7</sup> And I heard <sup>©</sup>I another from the altar saying, "Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous *are* Your judgments."

**Fourth Bowl: Men Are Scorched** <sup>8</sup> Then the fourth angel poured out his bowl on the sun, and power was given to him to scorch men with fire. <sup>9</sup> And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.

**Fifth Bowl: Darkness and Pain** <sup>10</sup> Then the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. <sup>11</sup> They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores and did not repent of their deeds.

**Sixth Bowl: Euphrates Dried Up** <sup>12</sup> Then the sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up, so that the way of the kings from the east might be prepared. <sup>13</sup> And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *coming* out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. <sup>14</sup> For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, *which* go out to the kings <sup>[g]</sup> of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty. <sup>15</sup> "Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed *is* he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame." <sup>16</sup> And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, <sup>[h]</sup> Armageddon.

**Seventh Bowl: The Earth Utterly Shaken** <sup>17</sup> Then the seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, "It is done!" <sup>18</sup> And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth. <sup>19</sup> Now the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. And great Babylon was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath. <sup>20</sup> Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. <sup>21</sup> And great hail from heaven fell upon men, *each hailstone* about the weight of a talent. Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.

- 1. (16:1) Voice of God: The voice of God shouting go pour out My wrath upon the earth. God pouring out His wrath tells us several things.
  - a. God is a just and righteous God is able to right all wrongs and get rid of all the evil in the world.
  - b. He will let the crazy evil sin hell bound world go on for so long.
- 2. (16:2) The first bowl of judgment: Sores very bad sores imagine the worst infection you have ever seen times a hundred. There will be agony and no rest, severe pain for all those who take the mark and follow the antichrist
- 3.(16:3) The second bowl: This bowl is poured out upon the sea, probably the Mediterranean sea because that is where the antichrist power will be in the Middle East.
- 4. (16:4-7) Bowl poured out upon the fresh water the drinking supply. Could you imagine turning your faucet on and red stuff coming out. All water will be contaminated.
- **Isaiah 45:21** <sup>21</sup> Tell and bring forth *your case;* Yes, let them take counsel together. Who has declared this from ancient time? *Who* has told it from that time? *Have* not I, the LORD? And *there is* no other God besides Me, A just God and a Savior; *There is* none besides Me.
- 5.(16:8-9) The bowl poured out on the sun: Severe heat radiation the air conditioners can't keep they will want to die and cant. And these people still won't repent.
- 6. (16:10-11) The fifth bowl poured out upon the throne of the antichrist. The antichrist and his followers will be in total darkness; you won't be able to see your hand in front of your face.
- **Joel 2:1-2** <sup>1</sup> The Day of the LORD Blow the [a]trumpet in Zion, And sound an alarm in My holy mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the land tremble; For the day of the LORD is coming, For it is at hand: <sup>2</sup> A day of darkness and gloominess, A day of clouds and thick darkness Like the morning *clouds* spread over the mountains. A people *come*, great and strong, The like of whom has never been; Nor will there ever be any *such* after them, Even for many successive generations.
- **Matthew 24:29** <sup>29</sup> "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken.
- 7. (16:12-16) The sixth bowl, the bowl of deception: The devil brings his troops to the valley of megiddo thinking he is going to win but it is a guaranteed loss for him because God has already won the battle.
- **Gog and Allies Attack Israel** Ezekiel 38,39 <sup>1</sup> Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, <sup>2</sup> "Son of man, set your face against Gog, of the land of Magog, [a]the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal, and prophesy against him, <sup>3</sup> and say, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal.

<sup>4</sup>I will turn you around, put hooks into your jaws, and lead you out, with all your army, horses, and horsemen, all splendidly clothed, a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords. <sup>5</sup> Persia, <sup>[b]</sup>Ethiopia, and <sup>[c]</sup>Libya are with them, all of them with shield and helmet; <sup>6</sup> Gomer and all its troops; the house of Togarmah from the far north and all its troops—many people are with you. <sup>7</sup> "Prepare yourself and be ready, you and all your companies that are gathered about you; and be a guard for them. 8 After many days you will be visited. In the latter years you will come into the land of those brought back from the sword and gathered from many people on the mountains of Israel, which had long been desolate; they were brought out of the nations, and now all of them dwell safely. <sup>9</sup> You will ascend, coming like a storm, covering the land like a cloud, you and all your troops and many peoples with you." 10 'Thus says the Lord God: "On that day it shall come to pass that thoughts will arise in your mind, and you will make an evil plan: 11 You will say, 1 will go up against a land of unwalled villages; I will go to a peaceful people, who dwell affely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates'— 12 to take plunder and to take booty, to stretch out your hand against the waste places that are again inhabited, and against a people gathered from the nations, who have acquired livestock and goods, who dwell in the midst of the land. <sup>13</sup> Sheba, Dedan, the merchants of Tarshish, and all their young lions will say to you, 'Have you come to take plunder? Have you gathered your army to take booty, to carry away silver and gold, to take away livestock and goods, to take great plunder?' "' 14 "Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say to Gog, 'Thus says the Lord God: "On that day when My people Israel dwell safely, will you not know it? 15 Then you will come from your place out of the far north, you and many peoples with you, all of them riding on horses, a great company and a mighty army. <sup>16</sup> You will come up against My people Israel like a cloud, to cover the land. It will be in the latter days that I will bring you against My land, so that the nations may know Me, when I am hallowed in you, O Gog, before their eyes." 17 Thus says the Lord God: "Are you he of whom I have spoken in former days by My servants the prophets of Israel, who prophesied for years in those days that I would bring you against them?

Judgment on Gog <sup>18</sup> "And it will come to pass at the same time, when Gog comes against the land of Israel," says the Lord God, "that My fury will show in My face. <sup>19</sup> For in My jealousy and in the fire of My wrath I have spoken: 'Surely in that day there shall be a great [e]earthquake in the land of Israel, <sup>20</sup> so that the fish of the sea, the birds of the heavens, the beasts of the field, all creeping things that creep on the earth, and all men who are on the face of the earth shall shake at My presence. The mountains shall be thrown down, the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.' <sup>21</sup> I will call for a sword against Gog throughout all My mountains," says the Lord God. "Every man's sword will be against his brother. <sup>22</sup> And I will bring him to judgment with pestilence and bloodshed; I will rain down on him, on his troops, and on the many peoples who are with him, flooding rain, great hailstones, fire, and brimstone. <sup>23</sup> Thus I will magnify Myself and sanctify Myself, and I will be known in the eyes of many nations. Then they shall know that I am the LORD."

Gog's Armies Destroyed Ezekiel 39 <sup>1</sup> "And you, son of man, prophesy against Gog, and say, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, [a]the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal; <sup>2</sup> and I will turn you around and lead you on, bringing you up from the far north, and bring you against the mountains of Israel. <sup>3</sup> Then I will knock the bow out of your left hand, and cause the arrows to fall out of your right hand.

<sup>4</sup> You shall <sup>[D]</sup>fall upon the mountains of Israel, you and all your troops and the peoples who *are* with you; I will give you to birds of prey of every sort and *to* the beasts of the field to be devoured. <sup>5</sup> You shall <sup>[D]</sup>fall on <sup>[D]</sup>the open field; for I have spoken," says the Lord God. <sup>6</sup> "And I will send fire on Magog and on those who live <sup>[D]</sup>in security in the coastlands. Then they shall know that I *am* the LORD. <sup>7</sup> So I will make My holy name known in the midst of My people Israel, and I will not *let them* profane My holy name anymore. Then the nations shall know that *I am* the LORD, the Holy One in Israel. <sup>8</sup> Surely it is coming, and it shall be done," says the Lord God. "This *is* the day of which I have spoken.

<sup>9</sup> "Then those who dwell in the cities of Israel will go out and set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and bucklers, the bows and arrows, the <sup>[i]</sup>javelins and spears; and they will make fires with them for seven years. <sup>10</sup> They will not take wood from the field nor cut down *any* from the forests, because they will make fires with the weapons; and they will plunder those who plundered them, and pillage those who pillaged them," says the Lord God.

The Burial of Gog <sup>11</sup> "It will come to pass in that day *that* I will give Gog a burial place there in Israel, the valley of those who pass by east of the sea; and it will obstruct travelers, because there they will bury Gog and all his multitude. Therefore they will call *it* the Valley of <sup>[a]</sup>Hamon Gog. <sup>12</sup> For seven months the house of Israel will be burying them, in order to cleanse the land. <sup>13</sup> Indeed all the people of the land will be burying, and they will gain renown for it on the day that I am glorified," says the Lord God. <sup>14</sup> "They will set apart men regularly employed, with the help of <sup>[h]</sup>a search party, to pass through the land and bury those bodies remaining on the ground, in order to cleanse it. At the end of seven months they will make a search. <sup>15</sup> The search party will pass through the land; and *when anyone* sees a man's bone, he shall <sup>[i]</sup>set up a marker by it, till the buriers have buried it in the Valley of Hamon Gog. <sup>16</sup> *The* name of *the* city *will* also *be* <sup>[i]</sup>Hamonah. Thus they shall cleanse the land."

A Triumphant Festival <sup>17</sup> "And as for you, son of man, thus says the Lord God, 'Speak to every sort of bird and to every beast of the field: "Assemble yourselves and come; Gather together from all sides to My sacrificial meal Which I am sacrificing for you, A great sacrificial meal on the mountains of Israel, That you may eat flesh and drink blood. <sup>18</sup> You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, Drink the blood of the princes of the earth, Of rams and Iamb Of goats and bulls, All of them fatlings of Bashan. <sup>19</sup> You shall eat fat till you are full, And drink blood till you are drunk, At My sacrificial meal Which I am sacrificing for you. <sup>20</sup> You shall be filled at My table With horses and riders, With mighty men And with all the men of war," says the Lord God.

## Israel Restored to the Land

<sup>21</sup> "I will set My glory among the nations; all the nations shall see My judgment which I have executed, and My hand which I have laid on them. <sup>22</sup> So the house of Israel shall know that I *am* the LORD their God from that day forward. <sup>23</sup> The Gentiles shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity; because they were unfaithful to Me, therefore I hid My face from them. I gave them into the hand of their enemies, and they all fell by the sword. <sup>24</sup> According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions I have dealt with them, and hidden My face from them." <sup>25</sup> "Therefore thus says the Lord God: 'Now I will bring back the captives of Jacob, and have mercy on the whole house of Israel; and I will be jealous for My holy name—

<sup>26</sup> after they have borne their shame, and all their unfaithfulness in which they were unfaithful to Me, when they dwelt safely in their *own* land and no one made *them* afraid. <sup>27</sup> When I have brought them back from the peoples and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, and I am hallowed in them in the sight of many nations, <sup>28</sup> then they shall know that I *am* the LORD their God, who sent them into captivity among the nations, but also brought them back to their land, and left none of them <sup>[k]</sup>captive any longer. <sup>29</sup> And I will not hide My face from them anymore; for I shall have poured out My Spirit on the house of Israel,' says the Lord God."

Daniel 7:19-27 19 "Then I wished to know the truth about the fourth beast, which was different from all the others, exceedingly dreadful, with its teeth of iron and its nails of bronze, which devoured, broke in pieces, and trampled the residue with its feet; <sup>20</sup> and the ten horns that were on its head, and the other *horn* which came up, before which three fell, namely, that horn which had eyes and a mouth which spoke appearance was greater than his fellows. 21 "I was watching; and the same horn was making war against the saints, and prevailing against them, <sup>22</sup> until the Ancient of Days came, and a judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time came for the saints to possess the kingdom.<sup>23</sup> "Thus he said: 'The fourth beast shall be A fourth kingdom on earth, Which shall be different from all other kingdoms, And shall devour the whole earth, Trample it and break it in pieces.<sup>24</sup> The ten horns are ten kings Who shall arise from this kingdom. And another shall rise after them; He shall be different from the first ones, And shall subdue three kings.<sup>25</sup> He shall speak *pompous* words against the Most High, Shall persecute the saints of the Most High, And shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand For a time and times and half a time.<sup>26</sup> 'But the court shall be seated, And they shall take away his dominion, To consume and destroy it forever.<sup>27</sup> Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.'

**Isaiah 11:4** But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.

**Isaiah 2:4** <sup>4</sup> He shall judge between the nations, And rebuke many people; They shall beat their swords into plowshares, And their spears into pruning [a]hooks; Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, Neither shall they learn war anymore.

8. (16:17-21) The seventh bow poured out upon the atmosphere:

The very air that men breathe will be affected, the giver of life is cutting off the air supply. This is what is going to happen to people if they don't repent and turn to Jesus. GO TELL SOMEONE!
